Mindanao Art Talks 2025

22-23 September, 2025 SM Lanang Cinema/Davao City National High School, Davao City

Rationale

An integral part of Mindanao Art since the fair's inception, MinArt Talks features conversations, lectures, and workshops with some of the country's leading figures in the creative industries, given free to the Mindanao public, specially its own local artists. The goal of MinArt Talks is to elevate the practice and consumption of creative expressions in Mindanao, offering opportunities for Mindanawons to deepen their understanding and appreciation of the arts.

This year's MinArt Talks will span two days, held in two different locations in Davao City.

On the morning of the first day, celebrated filmmaker and international writer Datu Teng Mangansakan, award winning playwright and theatre director Dr Steven Fernandez, and curator and textile researcher Prof. Leonardo Cariño give their takes on the year's theme of 'Leaping Beyond' at the SM Lanang Cinema. Facilitated by Karlo Antonio Galay David, the panel discussion will explore how Mindanao's creatives can pursue new heights.

On the second day, acclaimed painter Jun Impas will give a lecture on still life painting at the Davao City National High School Conference Room. After a performance by General Santos City's Teatro Ambahanon, he will then oversee a workshop with participants responding in art to the performance at DCNHS Gymnasium. In the afternoon respected sculptors Daniel Sollesta and Maria Magdamit give lectures and oversee a workshop on sculpting with clay.

MinArt Talks will take place simultaneously with the art fair, which will run from 21 September to 1 October, 2025 at SM Lanang.

Participation

All the components of MinArt Talks are free and open to the public, although students, teachers, and non-teaching staff of the Department of Education Region XI have been especially invited and are given priority.

Participants taking part in all the workshops are expected to bring their own art materials.
