4. Travelling and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local School/PTA funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.



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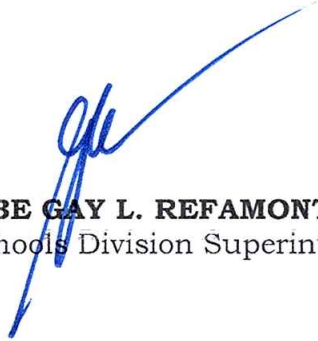

**2025 NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MONTH CELEBRATION AND
NATIONAL STUDENTS' DAY**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10661 which declares November as Buwan ng mga Bata and Republic Act No. 11369 designates November 17 of each year as a day to celebrate and recognize the vital role of students in nation building, this Office will conduct the 2025 National Children's Month Celebration (NCMC) and National Students' Day (NSD) at Panabo City Multi-Purpose Tourism, Cultural and Sports Center, National Highway, Panabo City on November 24, 2025. This will be hosted by the Division of Panabo City.

2. This annual celebration seeks to recognize active civic engagement and empower future leaders and changemakers. The observance of the NSD is also aligned to the principles of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), which uphold the importance of student voices and their contribution to society.

3. The participants of this activity are the Regional Federated Supreme Elementary and Secondary Learner Government Officers and Teacher-Advisers, Project Development Officers I (Youth Formation Coordinators), Division Learners Right and Protection Focals and identified learners and advisers from the Division of Panabo City.

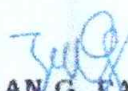
4. Further, participants are encouraged to bring school supplies or goods to be given to two hundred (200) school learners who were victims of the earthquake in Maray, Davao Oriental. This is a yearly reach-out program of the Regional Office through YFP dubbed as "Paskong Kay Saya Alay sa Mga Bata."

5. Schools must use the Automated Class and Teacher Scheduler (ACTS) as per Regional Memorandum No. 025, s. 2023 titled Regional Policy Guidelines in the Substitution of Classes and Grant of Service Credits during their participation in this activity. Learner-leaders must be on alternative delivery modality scheme to comply requirements while participating in the activities. Participants from other Divisions are allowed to travel a day before the activity and teaching and non-teaching personnel shall be given one day service credit/compensatory overtime credit.



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6. Lunch and snacks shall be charged against program support funds downloaded to Division of Panabo City while travelling and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
