

**MONITORING OF MULTIGRADE AND PROJECT E.A.G.L.E. SCHOOLS**

To: Assistant Regional Director  
Schools Division Superintendents

1. In support of the Regional Office impact evaluation research on Project E.A.G.L.E. (Elimination of Academic Gaps of Learners in the Elementary), and to ensure evidence-based validation of program implementation, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division shall conduct monitoring of multigrade schools and Project E.A.G.L.E. recipient schools. The list and the corresponding dates are indicated in the Enclosure.
2. The monitoring aims to:
  - a. validate the implementation status and fidelity of Project E.A.G.L.E. interventions in recipient schools;
  - b. document implementation practices and school-level enabling factors/constraints in multigrade settings;
  - c. gather quantitative and qualitative evidence to substantiate impact evaluation findings; and
  - d. identify actionable recommendations to strengthen learning recovery and reduce academic gaps among elementary learners.
3. Participation in Focus Group Discussion (FGD) and/or key informant interviews are school heads, teachers implementing the intervention, and other identified stakeholders as part of research substantiation.
4. Travel and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of onsite monitoring and related activities shall be charged against available local/downloaded funds, subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Further, schools are reminded that no lavish preparation shall be made for the monitoring activity, and all arrangements must ensure no disruption of classes and regular school operations.
5. Other details of the activity are enclosed.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
