2023 REGIONAL SCHOOL PRESS CONFERENCE (RSPC) QUALIFIERS

To: Public Schools District Supervisors
District Coordinating Principals
Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. Relative to the conduct of the 2023 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) with the theme, “From Campus Journalism to Real-World Journalism: Shaping Minds from Schools to Societies”, this Office advises the participation of the participants and qualifiers on the following activities. *(Please see attached 2023 RSPC guidelines enclosure 1 for the final list of activities).*
2. Attached is the list of the official participants and qualifiers for reference.
3. A registration fee of Eight Hundred pesos only (Php 800.00) shall be charged to each participants including the campus journalist, school paper adviser and coordinator, remitted in advance to the Davao Region Association of School Publication Adviser’s INC (DRASPA,INC) to defray expenses on certificates, medal, plaques, trophies, honoraria while meals, transportation and other related activities will be managed by the respective divisions, Membership fees of One Hundred Pesos (Php100) for the School Publication Adviser (SPA) and Ninety Pesos (Php 90.00) for Campus Journalist shall be collected by the DRASPA, INC. Treasurer, all are chargeable against School’s Maintenance and/ or other Operating Expenses/local/school/ Special Education Funds, School Campus Funds and other funds and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Service credits shall be granted to the teacher participants (DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2 2004) for service rendered during weekend, and holidays.

2023 RSPC GUIDELINE

General guidelines and mechanics:

1. All individual events and Group Events shall be conducted face to face which will be supervised by the Regional Focal in Campus Journalism with the assistance of our official Regional Technical Working Group, Division Education Program Supervisors Focal in campus Journalism and selected Public School District Supervisors, Principals and DRASPA Officers.
2. The proctors will facilitate the contest; the collection of outputs will be submitted to the designated room for scanning and uploading. Regional Technical Working Group Office.
3. Uploading of the outputs to the designated drive will be done after it was group in a folder by event/medium/level. Refer to Process Flow of the Contest – Submission of output.
4. To immerse the contestants with experiential journalism (gathering of data, organizing of data and broadcasting/ write-up of the news), a **press conference** shall be held as the basis for the content of Collaborative Publishing, Online Publishing, Radio Broadcasting and TV Broadcasting at the venue (Davao del Sur Coliseum)
5. During the press conference, the resource person will give an opening statement. Afterwards, two members from every Division (from any of the event - Elementary or Secondary) will be given the chance to ask a question and may add one (1) follow-up question. Each Division must agree whom to field. They are urged to listen to the questions asked and the answers so as not to repeat the same question already answered.
6. All members of the team must stay in their designated area at the venue following the health protocols as they take note of the discussion. Only the photographer (for collab), and videographers for TV accompanied by director/ standupper may be allowed to roam around the venue but within the designated place allotted for them to take photos and videos. Violation of this item is subject for disqualification.

7. Coverage in the production of outputs for Collaborative Publishing, Online Publishing, Radio Broadcasting and TV Broadcasting including its Infomercials must be based on the topics discussed in the Press Conference. Every topic in the output which is not based in the discussion during the press conference is subject to five (5) point deduction from the total score.

8. The time for the Collaborative Publishing and Online Publishing will start immediately after the press conference.

10. Refer to DepEd Memorandum No. 176, s. 2019, DepEd Memorandum No. 024 s. 2023 (NSPC 2023) for the guidelines of individual and group contests.

Additional info:

1. In order to determine the expected number of participants which is necessary in the preparation of the corresponding billeting rooms, venues and conference/contest materials, each division shall submit a soft and hard copies of the official list of Individual and Group events bearing the names of the contestants and coaches following the template given, which be endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendents to the Regional Office on June 2, 2023.
2. Registration fee amounting to Eight hundred pesos only (Php800.00) must be remitted directly to the **cashier** of DepEd RO XI and the membership fee of One hundred pesos for School Publication Adviser and Ninety pesos (Php 90.00) for Campus Journalist to DRASPA, INC Treasurer on June 8, 2023 at Digos City NHS or before the conduct of the activity.
3. Since the registration does not cover meals of the division delegation, they are advised to take care of their own food provisions. The Division may seek assistance from the Host Division through the Division Campus Journalism Supervisors as to arrangements for potential service providers.
4. Contestants and coaches who will stay in billeting schools are advised to bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, and blankets.
5. Contestants who will participate in an official capacity should be given recognition by their schools in accordance with the applicable Deped policy on awards and assessment and should be given consideration to make up for the full points of the projects, assignments, quizzes and other and other requirements that they missed.
6. Moreover, students are expected to stay at their designated areas (only at the billeting schools, contest venues and nearby stores to buy supplies or have some meals) for the duration of activity and should refrain from getting out except if they have secured permission thru a letter request signed by their parents/guardians and approved by the Division delegation head. In addition students should be accompanied by their teachers or relatives when getting out of the schools.

7. Submission of Documents of Outstanding School Publication Adviser and Campus Journalist will be on June 2, 2023 at DepEd RO XI. The interview schedule will be online on June 5, 2023 at 1:00 PM.
8. The Officers of DRASPA, INC are requested to meet a day before the RSPC to do the necessary preparations, collection of membership fee (Digos City NHS assigned office) and stay one day after its culmination, if needed to conduct a debriefing and make an accounting of all pertinent documents. Likewise the Regional Technical Working Group, Members of the Committees, Contest Facilitators and other support personnel shall also meet on the afternoon on June 8, 2023, 1:00 PM at Digos City National HS.
9. Additional requirements for official contestants and coach, bring School ID, secure medical certificates and parents consent to be submitted to the head of delegation.
10. Travelling and other incidental expenses incurred of the Technical Working Team, shall be charged against Local/School/ Division MOOE, Campus Journalism Funds, and other source of funds all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
11. Service credits shall be granted to the teacher-participant (DepEd Order no 53, s.2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No 2, s. 2004) for the services rendered during a Saturday and Sunday.

The school paper shall be submitted in **pdf format stored in 32G flash drive per Division** (top 5 winners) with the certificate of circulation duly signed by the principal and noted by Divisions-in-charge of journalism and approved by the Schools Division Superintendent, sealed on a short envelope on May 19, 2023, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM at Durian Hall, 3rd Floor, DepEd Regional Office XI.

Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the DepEd Region XI adheres to the rule concerning plagiarism. SDOs are enjoined to strictly follow the **“No School Paper, No Student Contestant”** in conducting the contest at the division level ensuring that all pupil/student participants have their respective published school paper.

The **top three winners** in all contest events per level per medium shall be recognized and the points garnered from individual and group contests shall be included in the computation of the overall scores following the guidelines. However, only the **1st Place winners in all events** will represent the region in the 2023 NSPC.
