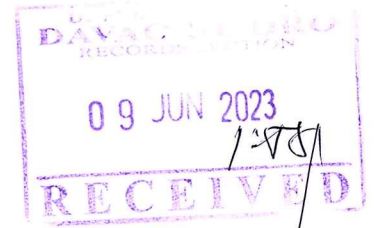

I. Rationale

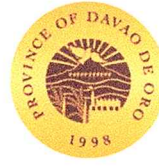
The Student Research Conference hosted by Davao de Oro State College, in collaboration with the Provincial Local Government Unit of Davao de Oro, provides a platform for students to showcase their research projects, share ideas and insights, and engage in critical thinking. Through this event, students can present their research to a broader audience and receive feedback from experts in their field. Additionally, the Congress encourages students to develop their research skills and explore new study areas.

The Conference also promotes research as an essential tool for academic advancement and personal growth. By participating in this event, students gain a deeper understanding of the research process, from identifying research problems to analyzing data and presenting findings. Furthermore, the Congress aims to cultivate a culture of research in the academic community by providing a venue for students to connect with other researchers, collaborate on future projects, and foster a sense of camaraderie and intellectual curiosity. Overall, the Student Research Conference is a valuable platform for students to showcase their research, develop their skills, and contribute to advancing knowledge.

II. Objectives

The objectives of the Student Research Conference are:

1. To provide a platform for students to showcase their research projects and findings, promoting their academic and research skills.
2. To promote intellectual discourse and collaboration among students from various institutions, leading to the formation of collaborations and networks.
3. To encourage and motivate students to engage in research and contribute to the advancement of knowledge in their respective fields.
4. To promote academic excellence and research culture among students by recognizing and rewarding outstanding research work.
5. To provide an opportunity for students to receive feedback and constructive criticism on their research work, helping them improve their research skills and methods.
6. To encourage the practical application of research work and its contribution to the development of the community and society.
7. To promote the values of academic freedom, intellectual curiosity, and critical thinking among students, contributing to the development of a knowledge-based society.



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Overall, the Student Research Conference aims to provide a platform for students to showcase their research skills, promote intellectual discourse and collaboration, encourage research culture and academic excellence, and contribute to the overall development of the academic community and society.

III. Categories

1. Senior High School – This is open to all senior high school students from the public schools of the Schools Division of Davao de Oro with completed research for School Year 2022-2023.
2. DDOSC College Students (all campuses) - This is open to all Davao de Oro State College students.

IV. Pre-Screening Process

- a. Senior High School Category – All interested participants need to submit their completed manuscript following the format mentioned in this guideline on or June 7, 2023 at research.main@ddosc.edu.ph. The top 10 pre-screened presentations will be notified through their respective email address.
- b. DDOSC College Students Category – All interested participants need to coordinate their respective Branch Research and Development Section for the pre-screening process. The Branch Research and Development Section will endorse to the Research and Development Division the finalist for the paper and poster presentation.

V. Paper Selection and Evaluation Process

1. From the papers presented, the best paper (per category) will be selected by the panel of judges and will be given a cash prize and a plaque of recognition, provided that it garners an average point score of 85 percent or higher. The next two best papers shall also be given cash prizes and plaques.
2. From all the posters, panel of judges will select the best poster/s and will be given a cash prize and a plaque of recognition, provided that it garners an average point score of 85% or higher. The next two best posters shall also be given cash prizes and plaques.

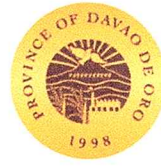
VI. Criteria for Judging

VII. Submission of Entries

1. BEST PAPER ENTRIES:

- a) Be properly endorsed by DepEd (for senior high school category) and Research Section Head (for DDOSC College Students category) to the DDOSC- Research and Development Division in three (3) printed copies (including e copy sent through email – rdd@ddosc.edu.ph) on or before May 19, 2023.
- b) Have quality breakthroughs/accomplishments. Not more than 30 pages including tables and figures, printed on A4 size bond paper, double-spaced, in 11 font size, preferably in Arial font.
- c) In a publishable format, papers should include:

e) Entries for the research category should include appropriate statistical analysis and have a consistent format presentation of graphs, tables, etc.

3. ORAL PRESENTATION

1. Presentation must be made by the principal/corresponding author or one of the authors.

2. All presentations must be in PowerPoint.

3. The file name of the PowerPoint presentation should be the title of the entry to be presented.

4. Text slides should be easily read from a distance of about 15-20 meters.

5. The maximum duration for presentation is 15 minutes. An additional 5 minutes will be allotted for questions of evaluators. If time permits, questions from the audience may also be entertained.

6. A digital copy (thru email) of the PowerPoint presentation must be received by the Secretariat a day before the Conference (until 5:00 pm only). Electronic copy may be sent in advance thru e-mail at rdd@ddosc.edu.ph, with a subject

containing the name of the school's name, last name of the presenter, current year of the conference, followed by the phrase "Student Congress". (Example: DDOSC DELA CRUZ 2023 STUDENT CONGRESS Entry)

7. Proceedings will be prepared after the symposium. Presenters who wish to make their papers/copy of presentations immediately available may bring extra copies for distribution to interested participants during the symposium. No photocopying facilities will be provided during the symposium.

Announcement of winners will follow right after the panel of judges has deliberated the result.
