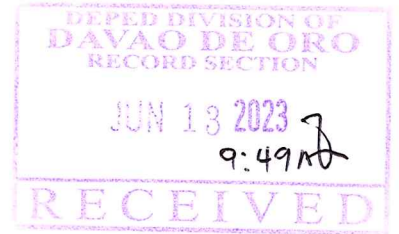

**1st DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION NATIONAL MONITORING  
AND EVALUATION CONFERENCE**

1. Consistent with Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 029, s. 2022 titled Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation (BEMEF) Framework, which mandates the institutionalization of the BEMEF in DepEd and in support of the Basic Education Development Plan (BEDP) and *MATATAG: Bansang Makabata, Batang Makabansa* Agenda, the Planning Service (PS) spearheads the development of new systems and processes for more effective and efficient support to the field offices and schools. Specifically, it focuses on standardizing the Department's policy development process, research management, planning and resource programming, data management, and monitoring and evaluation. These are essential areas in the overall improvement of DepEd operations.
2. In support of these education reforms and to keep the organization up-to-date with the current policies, trends, and practices on Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E), the Policy Research and Development Division (PRDD) under PS is conducting the **1st DepEd National Monitoring and Evaluation Conference** with the theme, M&E for Improved Basic Education Governance, from June 19 to 23, 2023 (inclusive of travel time) at Region XII (final venue will be announced later).
3. The conference aims to
  - a. set the direction of the Department's M&E system;
  - b. provide updates on the global and national M&E practices;
  - c. discuss the principles and standards of M&E;
  - d. discuss the M&E strategies and mechanisms of DepEd (e.g., Basic Education Information System, Learner Information System, Program Management Information System) as mechanisms of doing M&E in DepEd; and
  - e. promote cooperation among DepEd program managers and staff to support M&E initiatives across governance levels.
