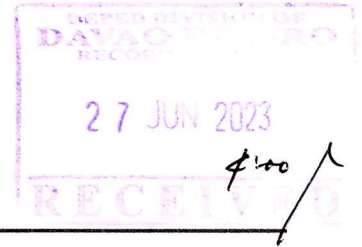

This has reference to the conduct of survey on the development of the restorative justice (RJ) program design in schools.

The Juvenile Justice Welfare Council (JJWC) leads the development of RJ program design that will produce a technical guide manual integrating RJ principles in all existing and future policies and programs on juvenile justice and welfare system. The manual will be a reference guide for the application of RJ in schools.

The Department of Education through the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) contributes in providing technical inputs and evidence-based information in the drafting of the technical guide manual based on the related learner protection guidelines, policies and programs on managing child-at-risk (CAR) and child in conflict with the law (CICL) cases.

This Region, through the Learner Rights and Protection Focal Person randomly selected the three Schools Division Offices (SDOs) namely, **Panabo City, Davao del Sur, and Davao de Oro** to participate in the baseline survey.

Anent to this, all Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) Focal Persons of concerned SDOs are required to randomly select two public elementary schools, two private elementary schools, two public high schools, and two private high schools in their respective area of responsibility.

Each of these participating schools shall randomly select ten teachers. It is requested that the teachers shall fill out the RJ Baseline Survey form through: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/BaselineSurveyonRJ> not later than **June 30, 2023**.



not later than **June 30, 2023**. The following requirements shall be observed in conducting the random selection:

1. Randomly select 3 Schools Division Offices (SDOs) per region, except the National Capital Region (NCR);
2. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in NCR shall participate in the survey;
3. Each participating SDO shall randomly select two (2) public elementary schools, two (2) private elementary schools, two (2) public high schools, and two (2) private high schools; and
4. Each participating school shall randomly select ten (10) teachers.
