The DepEd Learner Rights and Protection Office is mandated to lead in the planning, implementing, coordinating, monitoring and evaluation of programs, projects, and activities related to learner rights and protection in schools and at all governance levels of the Department, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2021.

Correspondingly, under DO No. 003, the Education Support Services Division at the Regional Level, the Schools Governance and Operations Division at the Schools Division Office Level, and the Child Protection Committees (CPCs) at the School Level are the coordinating arms of the LRPO for the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation, reporting, and coordination of learner rights and protection concerns.

Further, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012, or the "DepEd Child Protection Policy," all public and private elementary and secondary schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee, which shall be composed of the following, viz:

DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2021, "Creation of the Child Rights in Education Desk and the Child Protection Unit of the Department of Education," January 15, 2021.

- 1. School Head/Administrator Chairperson;
- 2. Guidance Counselor/Teacher-Vice Chairperson;
- 3. Representative of the Teachers as designated by the Faculty Club;
- 4. Representative of the Parents as designated by the Parents-Teachers Association:
- 5. Representative of pupils, students and learners as designated by the Supreme Student Council; and
- 6. Representative from the Community as designated by the Punong Barangay, preferably a member of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC)

Purthermore, LRPO has a separate unit, the Child Protection Committee (CPC) Functionality Support Unit, that takes charge of the assessment of the functionality of child protection committees (CPCs), learner rights and protection concern data, and monitoring and evaluation of CPCs.
