# NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH 2023

### Poster Making Contest Mechanics

- I. THEME: The theme for the observance of National Disaster Resilience Month 2023
  - "BIDAng Pilipino: Building a Stronger Filipino Well-being towards Disaster Resilience."

II. PARTICIPANTS: Participants of the Poster Making Contest are as follows:

- Elementary students from Grade 1 to 6
- High School students from Grade 7 to 10,
  - Senior High School students from Grade 11 to 12,
  - College/ Universities students, and
  - Provincial Office Employees
- III. Date and Venue: <u>July 28, 2023</u> at DepEd Division Training Center, Nabunturan Central Elementary School for DepEd Participants and PDRRMC Emergency Operations Center (EOC) at the PDRRMO compound for College participants and for PLGU Capitol Employees

### IV. POSTER MAKING CONTEST GUIDELINES:

- 1. All participants are entitled to one coach or chaperon.
- 2. Each participant will provide their own 20x30 illustration boards which will serve as their canvass. The name of the school/office of the participant should be pasted at the back portion of the board.
- 3. Basic drawing and coloring materials will also be provided by the participants. They may also opt to use other materials provided by the school or Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (LDRRMO) being represented, limited to crayons, oil pastels, coloring pencils, watercolors, poster paints and markers.
- 4. After the announcement of the central theme of the contest, the participants are given five (5) minutes to consult with the coaches. After that, the participants are given two (2) hours to work on their entries. No more coach or chaperon interference is allowed during this period.
- 5. The artwork shall follow a PORTRAIT orientation. No text or mark identifying the participant should appear on the artwork.
- 6. The organizers shall display a wall or digital clock so that participants are guided on the time limitations. The organizers should also announce the following during the contest time; last one hour, last thirty minutes, last fifteen minutes, last five minutes and last minute.
- 7. After the contest work period, all entries will be submitted to the organizer.
- 8. The panel of judges shall be composed of the following:
  - Chairperson: Vice-Chairperson, DDO PDRRMC Disaster Preparedness
  - Members: DepEd Division Office Representative
    - OCD XI Representative/PDRRMC CSO Member
  - Tabulator: PDRRMC DdO
- 9. Entries will be judged on the following criteria:
  - Overall Presentation, including creativity, color, harmony, etc. 50%

10. After the adjudication and tabulation of results, the panel of judges shall announce the winners of the contest during the culmination of the NDRM 2023, the decision of the panel of judges shall be final.

11. The top three winners will received the following prices:

1<sup>st</sup> Prize - PhP3,000.00.
 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - PhP2,000.00
 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - PhP1,000.00

### V. OTHER PROVISIONS

- 1. PDRRMC DDO shall have exclusive rights to the use of the top three (3) entries in its communications and publications materials, calendars and planner.
- 2. By joining the contests, all participants agree to release and discharge PDRRMC and its officials and employees from any claims, losses or damages arising from their participation.
- 3. Participants agree that their names and the name of schools represented may be released to the public for the purpose of announcing the contest finalists and winners.
- 4. Winning entries as appropriate may be considered by the PDRRMC for a possible **Mural painting** along the retaining walls at Daang Maharlika Highways such as, but not limited to Barangay Tuboran, Mawab, Davao de Oro.
- 5. Interested participants to the Poster Making Contest may be invited join the volunteer artists for the Mural Painting to be scheduled in the coming months as soon as finalized.
