- 3. In addition, it is emphasized that all teaching and non-teaching personnel of the Department of Education should refrain from taking part in political campaigns. DepEd officials are also barred from using their positions of authority to influence teachers and non-teaching personnel to support candidates or political parties.

REVISED CALENDAR OF ACTIVITIES AND PERIODS OF CERTAIN PROHIBITED ACTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE OCTOBER 30, 2023 SYNCHRONIZED BARANGAY AND SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN (SK) ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, the Commission on Elections (Commission) has promulgated on February 22, 2023 Resolution No. 10899 entitled "CALENDAR OF ACTIVITIES AND PERIODS OF CERTAIN PROHIBITED ACTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE OCTOBER 30, 2023 SYNCHRONIZED BARANGAY AND SANGGLINIANG KABATAAN ELECTIONS (BSKE)" prescribing the activities, periods and prohibited acts in connection with the October 30,2023 Synchronized Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections (BSKE);

WHEREAS, the existing political climate necessitates that the filing of certificates of candidacy be moved closer to the date of the election and at the same time taking into consideration the preparation for the pilot testing of the automated system for the BSKE;

WHEREAS, Section 29 of Republic Act No. 6646 provides:

"Sec. 29. Designation of Other Dates for Certain Pre-election Acts. - If it should no longer be reasonably possible to observe the periods and dates prescribed by law for certain pre-election acts, the Commission shall fix other periods and dates in order to ensure accomplishment of the activities so voters shall not be deprived of their right of suffrage.";

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the <u>Constitution</u> of the Republic of the Philippines, the Omnibus Election Code (B.P. Blg. 881), Republic Act Nos. 6646, 8189, 9164, 9340, 10632, 10656, 10742, 10923, 10952, 11935 and other election laws, the Commission on Elections RESOLVED to revise Resolution No. 10899. as follows:

Last day of posting of the Barangay and Sangguniang and Kabataan certified final Computerized Voters' Lists (CVL). (Sec. 30, R.A. 8189 as implemented by Sec. 62, Resolution No. 10868 dated November 29, 2022)

August 1, 2023 (TUE) to October 11, 2023 (WED)

Period to constitute the members of the Electoral Board and Barangay Board of Canvassers (BBOC).

August 15, 2023 (TUE)

Last day to conduct inspection of Voting Centers/Polling Places. (Sec. 1, par. 2, Article I, Resolution No. 10884 dated January 25, 2023)

August 28, 2023 (MON) to November 29, 2023 (WED) ELECTION PERIOD (Sec. 3, OEC, in relation to Sec. 29, R.A 6646)

Bearing, carrying transporting firearms or other deadly weapons in public including places, building, street, park, private vehicle or public conveyance, or even if licensed to possess or carry the same, unless authorized in writing by the Commission. (Sec. 261 (p), (q), OEC as amended by Sec. 32 of R.A. No. 7166); Use of security personnel or bodyguards by candidates. (Sec. 33, R.A. No. 7166); Alteration of territory of a precinct or establishment of a new precinct. (Sec. 5, R.A. No. 8189); Raising of funds thru dances, lotteries, cockfights,

Vote-buying and vote-selling. (Sec. 261 (a), OEC) Wagering upon result of election. (Sec. 261 (c), OEC); Transfer or detail of officers and employees in the civil service, including public school teachers. (Sec. 261 (h), OEC); Coercing, threatening, intimidating or terrorizing any election official employee in the performance of his election functions or duties. [Sec 261 (1), OEC]; (Note: **Prohibited** proclamation winning candidates) Illegal release of prisoners before and after elections. (Sec. 261 (n), OEC in relation to Sec. 29, R.A. No. 6646); Organization or maintenance of reaction forces, strike forces or similar forces. (Sec. 261 (u), OEC); and Suspension of local elective officials. (Sec. 261 (x), OEC).

August 28, 2023 (MON) to September 2, 2023 (SAT)

Filing of Certificate of Candidacy. (Sec. 39, OEC in relation to Sec. 7, R.A. No. 6679 and Sec. 29. R.A. 6646)

September 3, 2023 (SUN) to October 18, 2023 (WED) Campaigning. (Sec. <u>80</u>, OEC in relation to par. 3, Sec. <u>3</u> of the OEC);

September 15, 2023 (FRI)

Last day to file requests/petitions for transfer/change/correction of name/address of voting centers/polling places. (Sec. 11, par. 2, Article I, Resolution No. 10884 dated January 25, 2023)

October 19, 2023 (THU) to October 28, 2023 (SAT)

CAMPAIGN PERIOD (Sec. 7, R.A. No. 6679 in relation to par. 3, Sec. 3 of the OEC.) Holding of barangay assemblies candidates' fora (Sec. 47, and OEC)

Removing, destroying, obliterating, defacing, tampering or preventing distribution of lawful election propaganda. (Sec. 83, OEC); displaying, Posting, distributing and using illegal campaign materials. (Sec. 85, OEC) Making any donation or gift in cash or in kind. (Sec. 104, OEC) (Note: Also prohibited

on the day before election and on election day);

Appointing or using special policemen,

special/confidential agents or the like. (Sec. 261 (m), OEC) (Note: Also prohibited on the day before election and on election day);

Using armored land, water or craft. (Sec 261 (r), OEC) (Note: Also prohibited on the day before election and on election day);

Policemen and provincial guards acting as bodyguards public officials candidates. (Sec. 261 (t), OEC) (Note: Also prohibited on the day before election and on election day);

Release, disbursement expenditures of public funds (Sec. 261 (v), OEC);

Construction or maintenance of barangay funded roads and bridges. (Sec. 3, R.A. No. 6679, as amended by Sec. 4, R.A. No. 10923); Appointment or hiring of

new employees, creation of new positions, filling of new promotion positions, giving of salary increases,

remuneration or privileges in the barangay. (Sec. <u>5</u>, R.A. No. 10923).

October 29, 2023 (SUN) EVE OF ELECTION DAY

Campaigning. (Sec. <u>80</u>, OEC in relation to par. 3, Sec. <u>3</u> of the OEC));

Giving, accepting free transportation, foods, drinks, and things of value. (Sec. 89, OEC);

Selling, furnishing, offering, buying, serving or taking intoxicating liquor. (Sec. 261 (dd), (1), OEC).

(Note: Acts mentioned in the three preceding paragraphs are prohibited until election day).

October 30, 2023 (MON)

Casting of votes (From 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 3:00 o'clock p.m.)(Sec. 190, OEC)
Counting and canvassing of votes and proclamation of winning candidates immediately after closing of polls.

Campaigning. (Sec. <u>80</u>, OEC in relation to par. 3, Sec. <u>3</u> of the OEC));

Giving and/or accepting free transportation, food, drinks and things of value. (Sec. 89, OEC);

Using voter's affidavit of another for the purpose of voting, whether or not actually succeeds in voting. (Sec. 261 (y) (10), OEC);

Voting more than once or in substitution of another. (Sec. 261 (Z) (2) and (3) OEC);

Destroying, substituting, or away taking from the possession of those having legal custody thereof, or from the place where they are legally deposited, election from or document or ballot box which contains official ballots or other documents used in the election. (Sec. 261 (z) (12), OEC);

Soliciting votes or undertaking any propaganda for or against any candidate within the polling place or within thirty (30) meters 261 (cc) (6), thereof. (Sec. OEC); Selling, furnishing, offering, buying, serving or taking liquor. intoxicating (Sec.261 (dd), (1), OEC). Opening of booths or stalls for the sale, etc., of wares, merchandise or refreshments, within thirty (30) meters radius from the polling place. (Sec. 261 (dd) (2), OEC); and Holding of fairs, cockfights, boxing, horse races or similar 261 (dd) (3), (Sec. sports. OEC).

November 29, 2023 (WED)

Last day to file Statements of Contributions and Expenditures (SOCE). (Sec. 14, R.A. 7166)

The Education and Information Department shall disseminate copies of this Resolution, and shall cause its publication in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines. The Information and Technology Department shall likewise post a copy of this Resolution in the COMELEC website.

The Office of the Deputy Executive Director for Operations shall implement this Resolution.

This Resolution shall take effect on the seventh (7th) day after its publication in two (2) daily newspapers of general circulation in the Philippines.
