1. Each presenter is advised to prepare a Power point presentation, a copy of which should be submitted to the Policy Planning and Research Division on or before May 24, 2023.

2. The powerpoint presentation should have a maximum of fifteen (15) slides, and the font size should be at least twenty-four (24). Findings should be presented in a clear and concise manner by utilizing tables, charts, graphs, and other visuals to illustrate the data.

3. Each presenter will be given fifteen (15) minutes to present their work, followed by a five-minute open forum for questions and discussion.

4. PowerPoint presentations must include the following parts in bulleted form or in

a brief and easy-to-understand format:
