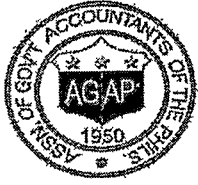


We would like to emphasize that due to existing health protocols, walk-in participants will **NOT** be allowed in the venue. Likewise, health and medical personnel shall be available during the event.
