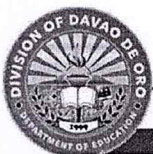

PARTICIPANTS' GUIDE

Overview

The Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) is the country's focal inter-agency body on children's concerns and welfare pursuant to its mandate as stipulated in Presidential Decree No. 603 (the first landmark legislation on children in the country). Despite the absence of regional presence, CWC works through the 17 Regional Committees/Sub-Committees for the Welfare of Children (RC/SCWC) and the Local Councils for the Protection of Children (LCPC) at the provincial, city and municipality levels.

As part of its efforts in organizing and strengthening LCPC, CWC came up with the "LCPCng Gumagalaw"¹ strategy. In partnership with the Union of the Local Authorities in the Philippines (ULAP) launched a nationwide LCPCng Gumagalaw Caravan. It served as the platform for LGUs/LCPC to share their good practices, challenges and lessons learned in upholding, promoting and protecting children and their rights.

The main responsibility in creating a protective environment for children lies within LCPC as stipulated in several laws (Civil Code of 1949, RA 4881 of 1967, PD 603 of 1974, RA 9344, as amended, among others). Numerous DILG Memo Circulars were likewise issued reiterating the organization, strengthening, monitoring and enhancing the functionality of these structures as the mechanism for the effective and efficient implementation of policies, programs and projects on children.

Direct provision of technical assistance (TA) to the LCPC is done through the RC/SCWC. More specifically, the major area for TA focuses on the formulation of the Four Legacies for Children, namely, Local Development Plan for Children (LDPC), Local Investment Plan for Children (LIPC), Local Code for Children (LCC) and Local State of Children's Report (LSCR).

For 2023, CWC through the Localization and Institutionalization Division (LID), seeks to mobilize all the 81 provinces, through their respective LCPC, with the PCPC as the movers and influencers in strengthening and capacitating their constituent LGUs to give a high premium on mainstreaming child rights in local governance.

The TA will focus on the **defining the processes involved in the development/updating** of the Four Legacies for Children. The initiative intends to assist and support the LGUs as they undertake their own processes in translating the successor plans of the National and Regional Plans of Action for Children (2023-2028).

Health Protocol

- In compliance with health protocol and safety measures, attending participants should be fully vaccinated. Everyone is reminded to bring their vaccination card on-site.
- Everyone is requested to wear a face mask and bring their own alcohol/sanitizers at all time.

Venue/Accommodation

- The activity venue will be at **Cavanico il Mare Beach Resort, Brgy. Camudmud, Babak, Samal, Davao del Norte.**
- Participants will be booked by the CWC at the hotel starting October 2, 2023 (Check-In) until October 6, 2023 (Check-Out).
- Attendees are requested to be at the venue by October 2, 2023 and program will start the following day at 8:30am. Please see the attached program for your reference.
- First meal to be served is dinner by October 2, 2023 and last meal provided is breakfast by October 4, 2023.
