This will be participated by the BERF grantees who have successfully uploaded their completed research in the E-Saliksik Portal.

1. Each presenter under the theme *Teaching and Learning* is advise to prepare a 5-minute video presentation of the completed research, a copy of which shall be submitted to the Policy Planning and Research Division on or before **October 11, 2023**. Findings should be presented in a clear and concise manner by utilizing tables, charts, graphs, and other visuals to illustrate the data.
2. After the video, a five-minute open forum for questions and discussion.
