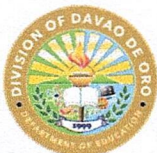

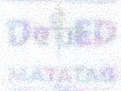

Rabies is an infection that affects humans usually transmitted by a bite or scratch of an infected animal. This is considered a significant public health problem in the country as it is one of the most acutely fatal infections and responsible for the death of at least 250-300 Filipinos annually mostly among children below 15 years of age and those who are poor.

Relative to this, the Department of Agriculture RFO-XI (DA- RFO XI) together with DOH Davao Center for Health Development (DOH-DCHD) and other collaborating agencies such as Department of Education RO XI (DepEd RO XI), Department of Interior and Local Government XI (DILG XI) and Department of Environment and Natural Resources XI (DENR XI) as members of the Regional Rabies Prevention and Control Program Committee (RRPCC XI) will conduct a **Rabies Awareness Forum** in celebration of **Rabies Awareness Month** by virtue of **Executive Order No.84, series of 1999**. The activity aims to provide information to our DepEd partner especially the school nurses or health coordinators on facts about rabies, rabies status in Region XI and protocols during biting incidents for animals and humans. This is in correlation to the high incidence of rabies in children in which our school nurses or health coordinators could provide proper guidance to the students and parents after exposure to the bite of the dog or other biting animal.


