A Ceremonial Signing of Regional Memorandum of Understanding on Enhanced Partnership Against Hunger and Poverty

Theme: Harmony in Innovation, Bridging Boundaries through Convergence"

Venue: The Ritz Hotel Hotel at Garden Oases, Obrerro, Davao City

Date & Time: 26 March 2024/2:00PM-6:00PM Dresscode: Modern Filipiniana & Barong Tagalog

Rationale:

With the aim of eradicating hunger, achieving food security, improving nutrition, and promoting sustainable agriculture, Executive Order No. 101, series of 2020, established the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) on Zero Hunger. This task force is mandated to pursue Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) Number 2 by ensuring that government policies, initiatives, and projects to achieve Zero Hunger are coordinated, efficient, and effective.

The Enhance Partnership Against Hunger and Poverty (EPAHP) stands as one of the flagship programs of the IATF. It represents a significant government initiative with the ultimate objective of eliminating hunger, ensuring food and nutrition security, and reducing poverty in both urban and rural communities. The program operates through synergistic efforts and convergence among various national government agencies, aligning itself with key national directives such as Ambisyon Natin 2040, the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028, Masusustansiyang Pagkain para sa Batang Pilipino Act, Kalusugan At Nutrisyon ng Mag-Nanay Act, Sagip Saka Act, and other administration directives.

In the Davao Region, the EPAHP was initiated on December 6, 2021, through a Regional Memorandum of Understanding signed by the Regional Directors of 21 National Government Agencies. These agencies include the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), Department of Agriculture (DA) and its attached agencies (National Dairy Authority, Agricultural Training Institute, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, National Food Authority, National Irrigation Administration, and Philippine Coconut Authority), Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP), Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Health (DOH), National Nutrition Council (NNC), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Commission on Population and Development (CPD), Cooperative Development Authorities (CDA), Landbank of the Philippines (LBP), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC), and Department of Trade and Industry (DTI).

Over the past three (3) years, the program's implementation has yielded positive impacts on farmers and community-based organizations. Collaborative meetings, capability building activities, creation of market opportunities, provision of technical assistance, financial support,

farm inputs, and equipment have been instrumental in advancing agricultural development and community empowerment.

The cumulative effect of these efforts has produced a positive ripple effect on the socioeconomic conditions of the community. Improved agricultural practices contribute not only to food security but also to increased income and resilience among farmers. Community-based organizations play a pivotal role in fostering a sense of collective responsibility and mutual support.

As of December 31, 2023, the EPAHP Regional Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has expired, prompting unanimous agreement among members of the Regional Convergence Team to forge a new agreement. This collective decision reflects a shared commitment to sustaining and amplifying the program's impact, ensuring the ongoing success of collaborative efforts. Importantly, the program has attracted increased interest from new partners, acknowledging it as an exemplary platform for resource mobilization and breaking down barriers between agencies.

On March 26 2024, "PANAGHIUSA SA ONSE" with the theme: "Harmony in Innovation, Bridging Boundaries through Convergence" shall be spearhead by the Department of Social Welfare and Development Field Office XI, being the lead and secretariat of the EPAPH Regional Convergence Team. Said activity is a celebration of victory for the three (3) years successful EPAHP implementation. It is an inspiring collaboration among National Government Agencies and other stakeholders to continue driving innovation, foster meaningful connections and create a synergy that transcends traditional boundaries. By promoting convergence, we believe in unlocking new opportunities, sparking creativity, and addressing challenges collectively within the region especially addressing hunger and poverty.
